Saving Families Group Home is a licensed long-term facility in Chesterfield County for at-risk children, ages 12 to 17 years. It provides a safe place when children are removed from their families and not able to be placed in a foster home. Abuse can be present in many forms, such as physical, mental, emotional, sexual, neglect and/or abandonment.

## Our Home

Najai's House is a licensed long-term facility. The four-bedroom home has a quiet room, a family filled environment and is filled with welcoming toys, games, stuffed animals and books for the children.

## Our Children

Children, ages 12 to 17, are removed from their homes due to physical/emotional abuse, abandonment, at risk children that may end up homeless because they are unable to find shelter with a foster family", and neglect and is in need of a safe place.

## Our Staff & Volunteers

The children are cared for by a group of screened, qualified and trained staff, as well as volunteers to provide trauma-informed care to our children.

## Our Program

There are times when children are removed from their homes and need a place to go that will feel as if they are at home until they can find the best placement. Saving Families Group Home will serve as a "soft landing" so the children are cared for in a safe and welcoming environment and not re-traumatized during the process of removing them from their homes.

## Our Community

Although Saving Families Group Home is located in North Chesterfield, VA, the home serves physically/emotionally abused, abandoned at risk youth, and neglected children from the entire state of Virginia.
